Ben Shahn (September 12, 1898 – March 14, 1969) was a Lithuanian-born American artist. He is best known for his works of social realism, his left-wing political views, and his series of lectures published as *The Shape of Content*. Café Conversations coincide with a tour of a related special exhibition or works from the Brooks permanent collection. Led by Memphians, the series encourages visitors to contemplate real life issues by drawing comparisons to themes in art.
